STAR MONEY moved up three wide between rivals nearing the turn and prompted the pace, forged to command in upper stretch, edged clear under left handed pressure nearing the eighth pole, raced erratically in the final furlong and held sway under a drive. G'S BACKINACTION was taken to rate early while saving ground, eased off the rail mid turn and advanced between rivals into the lane, swung out for the final furlong and closed well. POLISH DANCE pressed the pace two wide, continued to battled between foes into the stretch then gave way grudgingly. ICE ON THE SIDE broke a tad slow, was hustled up inside rivals to take command leaving the chute, set a pressured pace along the rail, had her rider lose his whip in upper stretch, held well to the eighth pole then gave way. CONGRESIONALAFFAIR, well placed along the rail, failed to respond. GLORIOUS MELODY lost ground four wide stalking the pace and gave way after a half mile. ROMA'S GIRL chased the early pace four wide and dropped back. ROYAL TIDINGS was eased in upper stretch and walked off.
