Footnotes

POLISH DANCE came out a bit at the break, was rated forwardly off the rail, rallied three wide between rivals in mid stretch, dueled along the rail and inside PROSECCA through the final sixteenth and just got up in an extended drive. PROSECCA, taken to rate three to four wide just off the pace, angled out five wide into the lane, responded to strong left handed pressure to gain a slim lead in mid stretch, drifted in towards the rail, dueled outside the winner and just missed in a sharp try. RUNAWAY VALAY set a pressured pace inside, drifted off the rail into the lane, continued to battled past the eighth pole then faded. SUEGRA, urged along pressing the pace outside RUNAWAY VALAY, drifted out four wide into the lane and tired. SHEZA WONDER saved ground leaving the three eighths pole stalking the pace and weakened.
